The **Fertility** $Care^{TM}$  **Practitioner** Program is a one-year program and prepares students to teach the CREIGHTON MODEL Fertility $Care^{TM}$  System to women and couples from any reproductive category.

- National Standardized final exam

The **Fertility** *Care*<sup>™</sup> **Instructor** Program is a 6-month program and prepares students to teach the basic method to women and couples of most reproductive categories.

- One Education Phase
- One Supervised Practica
- National Standardized final exam

A FortilityCare<sup>TM</sup> Instructor must work under a FortilityCare<sup>TM</sup> Practitioner and cannot teach independently.

Accommodations, lodging and meals will be provided

Education Phase I (EP I) is an 8 day total immersion educational experience that prepares the intern to teach the CREIGHTON MODEL Fertility $Care^{™}$  System. Supervised Practicum I (SPI) begins with the successful completion of EP I. At this time the student is given all the teaching materials they need to teach 18 client couples. Practitioner and Instructor Interns begin establishing their centers and teaching the Fertility $Care^{™}$  System as soon as they return home from EPI. During the next six months a faculty member will supervise them through an innovative system of long distance assignments, phone calls, and problem solving tools.

**Education Phase II** (EPII) where they explore Advanced Issues in Fertility $Care^{^{70}}$  System, Advanced Case Management, Pregnancy Evaluations, and Comprehensive Case Reviews.

After successful completion of EPII the Fertility *Care*<sup>™</sup> Practitioner Intern again returns home to continue teaching and complete the requirements of Supervised Practicum II (SPII). Sometime during SPII their faculty supervisor will conduct a Site Visit at the student's home location. When these requirements are complete the Practitioner Intern will qualify to take the national standardized final exam. Upon completion of the program the student will receive a certificate Fertility Care<sup>™</sup> Practitioner Fertility Care Instructor from Eco Medicum Fertility Care Services

# **Applicant Eligibility**

eligible for the **Fertility** $Care^{TM}$ Those **Practitioner** Program are registered nurses with current licenses, allied health professionals with a degree in health, behavioral sciences, social sciences, or education. Other non-health fields are also individually recognized. Also eligible persons with associate are degree/diploma such as: licensed practical nurse, human services practitioner, or the equivalent of two years of university education. Further eligibility criteria requires that the applicant(s) practice (use) the CREIGHTON MODEL **Fertility**Care<sup>™</sup> System or, if single and celibate, monitor their natural fertility and be a philosophical acceptor of the System.

## **Costs and Fees**

The tuition and costs of books and materials for the entire program is \$4,000 US This amount may be payable as a deposit of \$500 US and the balance of \$3,500 in 2 installments prior to the beginning of EPI and EPII In addition there are costs associated with an On Site Visit that will be conducted at the student's location during the second Practicum. These costs include travel and hotel room for one night for the student's Supervisor and are payable at the time of the OnSite Visit. In addition there is a fee of 50.00 USD for the national standardized final exam and the cost of teaching materials.

The **CREIGHTON MODEL Fertility** $Care^{\top}$  System **Practitioner** and **Instructor** Programs of Eco Medicum Fertility Care Services are accredited by the American Academy of **Fertility** $Care^{\top}$  Professionals and abide by its Standards. Upon completion of the Program our graduates will be eligible to apply for certification through the Academy.

Advanced educational materials, books and study guides are sent to the student when they have been accepted into the program. It is recommended that this process begin as soon as possible to allow the student the time needed to prepare for Education Phase I.
